Standard Learning Agreement - SCUBA Courses

This Learning Agreement Constitutes an Understanding of Responsibilities Between Confederation Divers, the Course Instructor(s) and the Student. Please carefully read this Agreement, ask any questions and then sign and date this document with your Instructor.

Welcome to the Course! SCUBA Courses are designed to be safe and fun, but in order to get the most out of your course you will need to invest some time and effort in preparing for each session.

Student Responsibilities - The Student Agrees to:

- Prepare in advance the assigned Academic portions of the course, including Knowledge Reviews at the end of each chapter, which must be handed in to the Instructor.
- Arrive on time and equipped for any in-water sessions with the student's own gear (if any), swimwear, course paperwork and Student Logbook. Be physically and mentally prepared for in-water activities (i.e. get proper rest, food and fluids).
- Ask questions about any course materials or procedures the Student does not fully understand.
- Bring any new medical concerns (new medications, colds, etc if not covered on the Medical Form) or anxieties to the attention of the Instructor as soon as possible, and without fail before any in-water training activities. This is critical for the Safety of the Student and Instructor, as well as other Students, Divers and CD Staff.

If the Student fails in any of the above such that a session is missed, the Student bears responsibility for additional costs incurred. CD agrees to show all reasonable understanding in the event of personal emergency or illness requiring a doctor's visit.

Instructor (s') Responsibilities - The Instructor Agrees to:

- Provide a professional, positive and enjoyable environment for learning.
- Make every effort to adhere to Course Schedule, with the exception of unforeseen events including but not limited to Inclement Weather or Unsafe Conditions.
- Answer all Student questions to the best of their ability.
- Assist the Student through unique learning challenges, if the Student prepares sufficiently, as deemed by the Instructor, for all portions of the Course and still experiences difficulty with course requirements.
